# Global Citizenship – an overview

---

- Global Citizenship describes a sense of **belonging** to a larger **global community**, a recognition that every person is a citizen of the world and that we all have **responsibilities** to each other and to our planet.
- It involves understanding and appreciating **diverse cultures, perspectives, and ways of life**, as well as recognizing and **addressing global challenges** such as climate change, poverty, inequality and armed conflict.
- A **global citizen strives to be informed and engaged** in both **local and global issues**, **collaborating** with others to promote a **kinder, fairer and more sustainable world** for all.

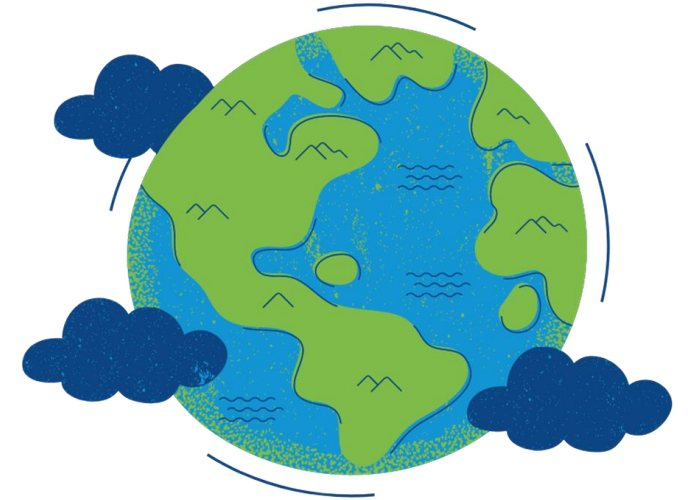

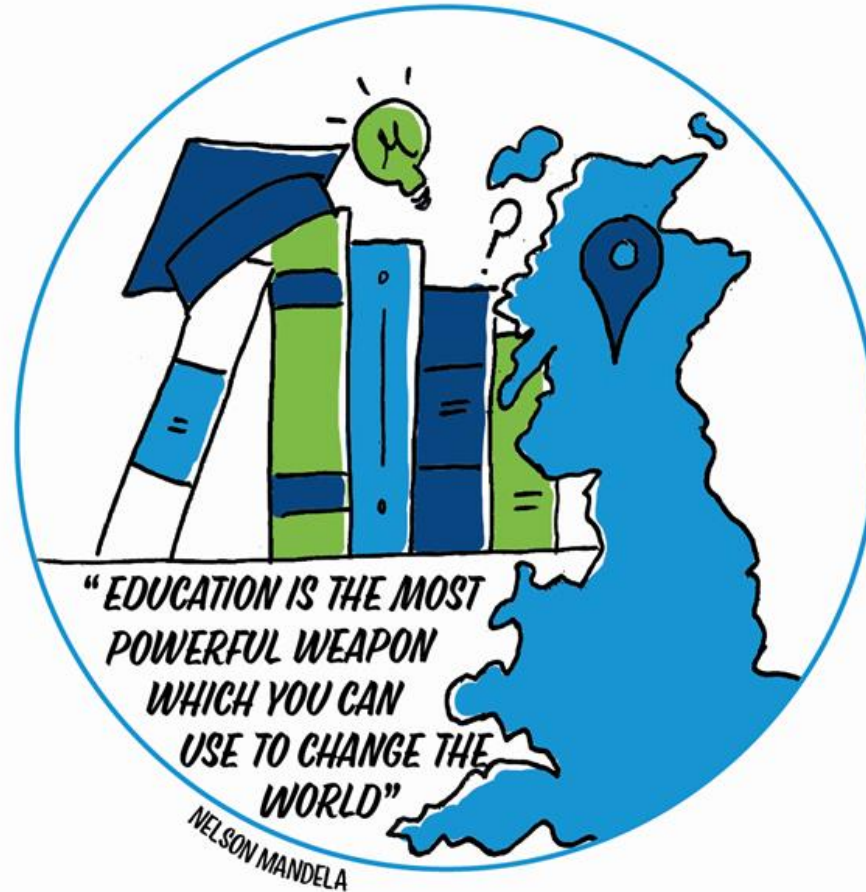
